

Sony PlayStation Proposed Class Action Update

This is to advise of the status of this matter.

The Statement of Claim was issued May 2, 2011. We are in the process of arranging for the various Sony defendants to be served with the Statement of Claim.

Based on information disseminated by Sony, it appears that the information obtained from its computers includes the names, addresses, email addresses, birthdates, and passwords of registered PlayStation Network and Qriocity users. We understand that Sony has advised as follows: “To protect against possible identity theft or other financial loss, we encourage you to remain vigilant, to review your account statements and to monitor your credit or similar types of reports.” However, to our knowledge Sony still has not indicated whether it will pay for Canadians to obtain credit searches, arranging credit monitoring services and/or obtaining fraud insurance.

We will keep you posted as matters progress.
